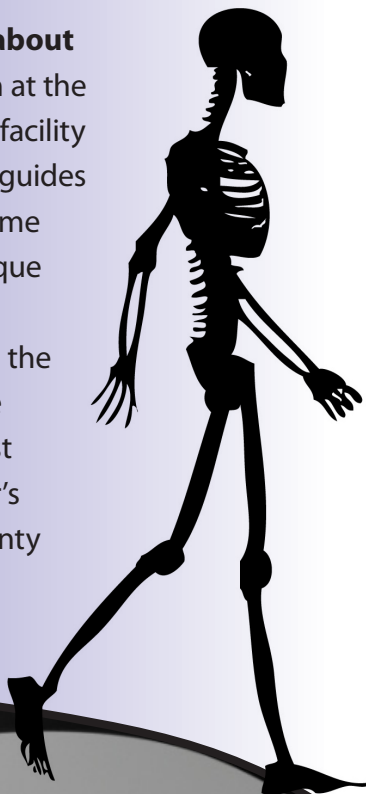
WALKARLINGTON'S WESTOVER WALKABOUT
