Just a stone's throw from the Pentagon, Fairlington was constructed with public dollars close to the end of World War II. It is a nationally significant example of large-scale, publicly-financed defense housing that was intended to last far beyond the end of the war — and it has! Fairlington is listed on both the National Register of Historic Places and the Virginia Landmark Register.
