

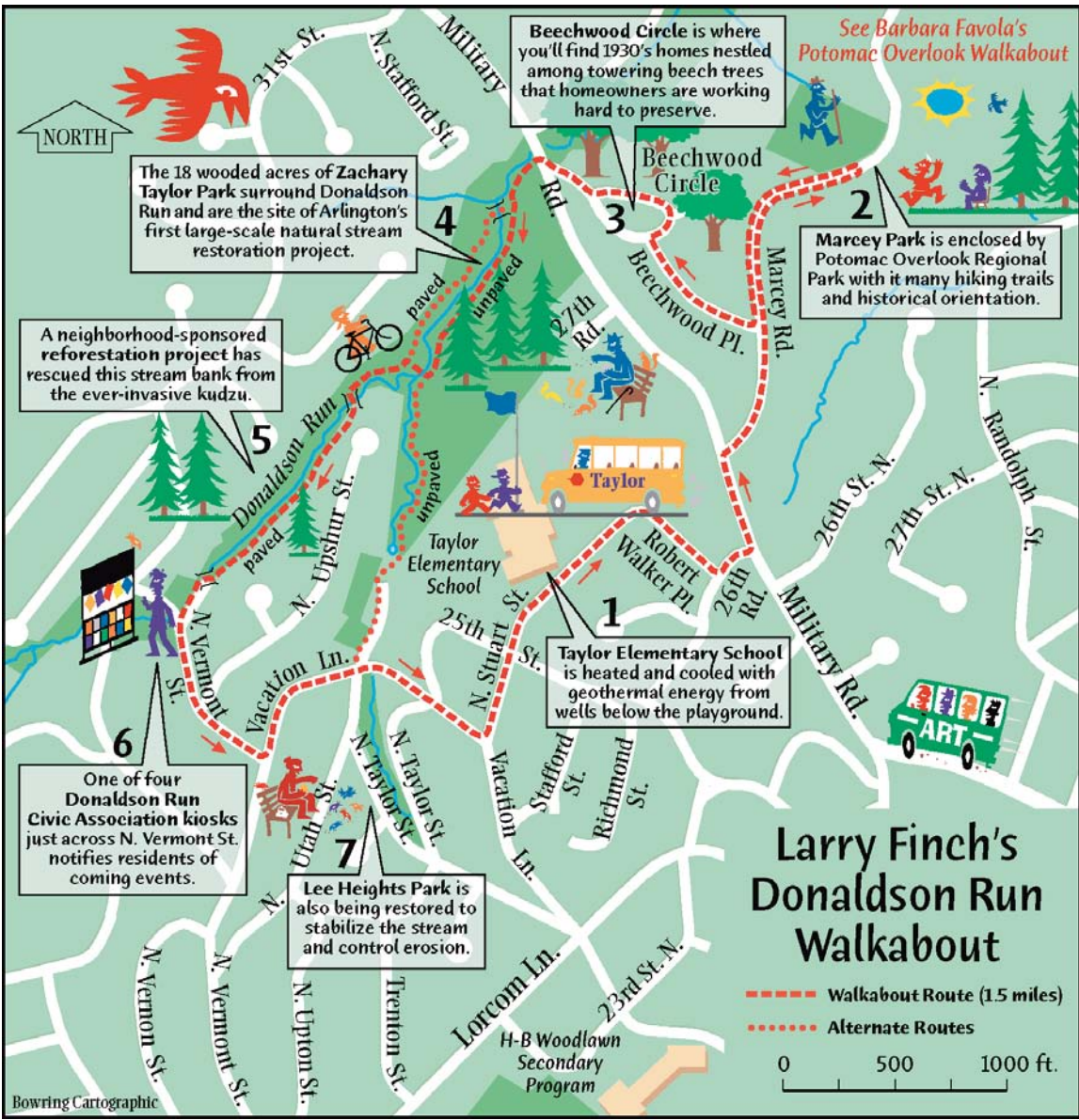


# WALKArlington Walkabouts: Donaldson Run

**Length:**  
One and one half miles

**Terrain:**  
Hilly in places

**Ambience:**  
Quiet residential streets; stream-valley park; neighborhood schools and university.



Donaldson Run is bounded on two sides by open space: a golf and country club to the north, and a regional park to the east. It is a quiet, close-in, wooded community with a small-town feel.

The neighborhood was developed primarily during the late 1940's and 1950's. At its heart is a system of parks following Donaldson Run, the stream after which the community is named. The character of the neighborhood is shaped to a large extent by the parks and the trees that shade the homes and yards.
