Ashton Heights is a quiet residential community of approximately 1800 households dating back to the early 1900's. Situated in the geographic "heart" of the county, this community grew up around the (now defunct) Clarendon electric trolley station. Over the years, Ashton Heights has experienced expansion, decline, and more recently, revitalization thanks in large part to the aggressive planning efforts of citizens and staf

Described by the Washington Post as having "a feeling of historic depth," Ashton Heights is convenient to Metro, shopping facilities, libraries, cultural and recreational centers.
