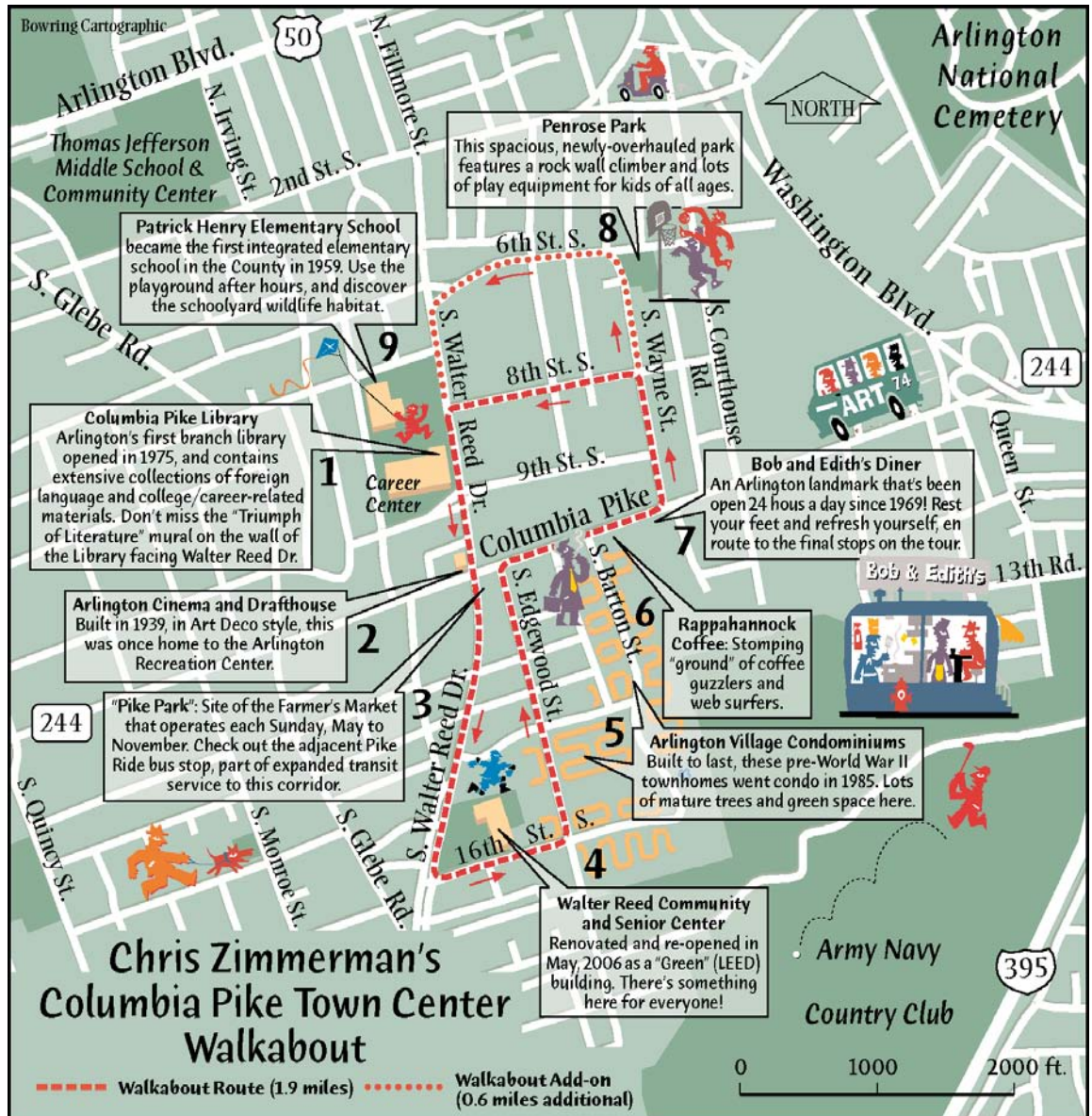

Columbia Pike dates back almost as long as the borders of the county. In 1801 Congress chartered a company to create a road here — and the Columbia Turnpike was born.

Though it has undergone a number of name changes, the Pike has long provided a way for folks to get to and from the District of Columbia from Arlington, the far reaches of Fairfax County and beyond.

A vast array of eateries with American and international offerings continue to find their way to Columbia Pike — a reflection of the diverse backgrounds of the residents in the surrounding communities.
